

PADRE'S CORNER MAY 8, 2016

Tanzania is a missionary territory that the Maryknoll order ministers to, and invites people of all stripes and colors to experience as an outgrowth of educational pursuits and spiritual development. I sponsored an Irish friend a few months ago, evolving out of my own Maryknoll pilgrimage three years ago to the Central American countries of Guatemala and El Salvador. On that trip I saw places of martyrdom for the faith, suffered by many priests and nuns. Their courageous stories will never be forgotten by me. These wonderful religious defended their people against injustices instigated by the hands of the official government, hostile to human rights. Maryknoll nuns were among the victims, left on a roadside in the capital San Salvador like they were meaningless blobs of tissue. Archbishop Oscar Romero was assassinated also in that city area on March 24, 1980 while saying Mass at a hospital chapel. I was part of a group of priests and deacons that worshipped at that very altar. My friend Katie had a different testimony in Tanzania. She saw people struggling to survive, but clinging to faith and family to endure. One woman with severe cerebral palsy (malfunctioning of the brain and nervous systems) would crawl to the parish church each day to attend Mass from her home, and the priest would then bring her Holy Communion at the appropriate time. The simplicity of living, uncomplicated by the material and financial obsessions of our modern American culture, is engrained in the lifestyles and habits of major sections of the overall world population. Americans, myself included, are often obsessed by the results of our favorite sports teams and the deaths of entertainment giants. This is why travel to learn other viewpoints is beneficial.

Self-examination is not easy, often involving painful introspection. The internal process is difficult, as we also apply the lens of what the expectations of God is in our life. He wants us to live for Him, but we all often fall way short. We can become frustrated by our failures, which our prayers and His grace can help us to conquer. (Be inspired by these words of the Jentezen Franklin Media Ministries, in an article entitled "Rebounding Out of the Snare of the Devil. " ... Inevitably, there will be times in each of our lives where we miss the game-winning shot. We all fail. We all fall short. But do you know something? God has never sought after perfect people. Think about it. Moses murdered someone and then went into hiding. David committed adultery, and had a man killed to cover it up. Samson chose a woman over his calling. Peter pronounced boldly he had nothing to do with Jesus Christ, not once, but tree times! These were not accidents; these were intentional sins. God had every right to smite them. But what did He do? He used them. Moses became the deliverer of millions of Israelite people. David was one of Israel's greatest kings. Samson's calling was never revoked. And out of all the disciples, it was Peter whom Christ chose to build His church. Maybe you, like these men, have made some pretty poor choices. You may have experienced disappointment in your marriage, or maybe you have given up on a God-given dream... God is in your corner! He is for us, not against us. He forgives us because He loves us, blots out our mess-ups for His own sake. He chooses not to bring up our past, yet sees us for who we will be. If He isn't holding your wrongs against you, why are you holding them against yourself? Honestly repent of that which is holding you back, praise Him, and know that you are standing on a firm foundation. One that has unlimited second chances.") I hope our parish can be a place of renewed vision, as individuals and a community of believers. Our times worldwide are trying, and can test even the spiritually strong. Let us help each to His path and will. Blessings. Father Bill
